## Instructions for Installing Homefires Electric Fires

**Included with your purchase should be the following:**

1 electric burner shell (with/without heater), 4 glass “squares”, 2 fireglow light bulbs, 2 “Spinners”, 2 spinner brackets, and a box with colored glass and coals.



- 1) Plug the burner in to a 110 V socket and turn the unit on. If you have a unit with a heat blower then engage the far right switch on the heater. If no heater is present, then turn the control coal to the on position. To turn the heater on, engage the middle switch for 1KW heat and both switches for 2KW heat. After checking to see that the lights illuminate and that the heater (if present) works, turn the unit off.
- 2) Place the spinner bracket(s) on the two bulbs so that the pin points straight up. Now place the spinners on top of the pin-point (as shown in the illustration above). When the bulbs are illuminated, they will give off enough heat to cause the spinners to rotate; thus giving a glittering effect to the electric burner when all said and done.
- 3) With the texture facing out, slide the square pieces of glass into position on the front 2 openings from the side. Secure the glass pieces into place with the metal tabs and lower the burner assembly into the firebasket from above.
- 4) Slide the shell as far back and as close to the backplate as possible. Place the remaining glass pieces (texture facing out) on top of the shell.
- 5) Carefully decorate the open spaces and top with the glass and coal pieces provided.
